HEALTH & SAFETY

General information

- ▶ We take health and safety very seriously at Cardiff Marina, we ask that you familiarise yourself with the layout of our marina and the safety notices
- ▶ There are a number of life rings, ropes, ladders and fire extinguishers situated around the marina for your safety marked as 'Emergency Points' please see the plan on the reverse side of this information sheet for their positioning
- ▶ We ask that you take care at all times whilst on the pontoons and running is strictly prohibited
- ▶ Swimming and diving are not permitted in the marina
- ▶ Please report any damage or faults to the Marina Office
- ▶ Exit points are situated at the slipway at the near end of the marina and by the walkway next to the Marina Office
- ▶ There is a first aid box in the Marina Office (available during office hours only)
- ▶ Please be courteous to other marina users at all times
- ▶ Users of the car park do so at their own risk. The management will not accept responsibility for any damage, loss or accidents
- ▶ Please be courteous to other car park users at all times.

Cables and hoses

- ▶ Users of the pontoons are to be aware of cables and hoses on the walkways
- ▶ Please ensure all electric cables are in good condition before use and comply with I.E.E. standards
- ▶ Please ensure all cables are run safely along the pontoons as not to cause a trip hazard
- ▶ Please ensure all water hoses are run safely along the pontoon as not to cause a trip hazard
- ▶ Please ensure all water hoses are replaced in the correct location after use.

Fire

In the event of a fire:

- ▶ Call the emergency services, dial 999
- ▶ Stay calm and raise the alarm to others nearby
- ▶ Vacate the area
- ▶ Inform the Marina Office 029 2034 3459 and Barrage Control 029 2070 0234 or channel 18 VHF

Fueling

- ▶ In an emergency please clear the pontoons in a calm and orderly fashion
- ▶ All fueling must be carried out at the designated fueling berth
- ▶ Petrol boats are advised to fuel up at Penarth Marina
- ▶ Please report any spillages to the Marina Office and to Barrage Control on Channel 18.
