An introduction to Cardiff Marina

Cardiff Marina is part of the Cardiff Marine Group and provides a prestige environment for Cardiff Bay's fast growing boating community. It offers safe, secure and sheltered moorings in the heart of Cardiff Bay.

Back in 2001 the Cardiff Bay Barrage transformed Cardiff Bay and created a 200 hectare freshwater lake. It has made the Bay an attractive and approachable environment for boat users of all standards. With 24 hour access to the Bristol Channel, affordable moorings and superb road links, Cardiff Marina is ideal for boat owners from South Wales, Birmingham and the South West of England.

Cardiff Marina's moorings run alongside a £1 billion regeneration project in Cardiff Bay known as the International Sports Village. Facilities and attractions include a 50 metre swimming pool, a leisure pool, spas and a health and fitness centre as well as an ice rink and a supermarket within walking distance. Future development will include a white water rafting centre, a snow dome and a multi sports arena.

Cardiff is a vibrant capital city. Just a short cruise from Cardiff Marina is Mermaid Quay and the Millennium Centre. With pay and display moorings these exciting developments offer a stunning waterside location with over 20 bars and restaurants and a world-class concert hall and theatre.

In the last twelve months Cardiff Marina has undergone a dramatic transformation and grown from approximately 40 berths to the 200 that are there today. Further growth is planned for the end of the year to provide a total of 350 berths.

Significant investment has been made by the Cardiff Marine Group to ensure that Cardiff Marina provides every facility that a boat owner would expect from a first class marina. This includes high quality pontoons, a state of the art security system, electricity and water meters to every berth, brand new showers and toilets and complimentary WiFi and car parking.
